ITEMS FOR ADDENDUM #1:

Q: Will the county accept pricing as "profit margin" over the Austin Daily OPIS Contract Average price for date of delivery for gasoline and diesel?

A: Yes, please submit fuel price as a percentage added to the daily rack rate.

Q: Do bidders have to submit a price for every product in order to be responsive?

A: No. Only bid on the items your company can supply.

Q: What location(s) receive the engine oil, hydraulic fluids, and gear lubes?

A: Precinct 1, Precinct 2, Precinct 3, and Precinct 4 all order and receive oil, hydraulic fluid and gear lubes.

Q: What kind of tanks are at each location (above or below ground)?

A: Above ground

Q: Can you provide what kinds of fuels are being delivered to specific locations? (ie. What kind of fuel tank is located at Precinct 1?, etc.)

A: Precinct 1, Precinct 2, Precinct 3, 911 Communications, and the Law Enforcement Center have diesel tanks only. Precinct 4 has gasoline, on-road and off-road diesel tanks. Bastrop county will also have an additional 774-gallon diesel tank located at 15 American Legion Dr., Bastrop, Tx 78602 coming online in the fall of 2026.

Q: For the engine oils, hydraulic fluids, and gear lubes, do you require branded oils?

A: Bastrop County is not brand specific for these products. All motor oil, hydraulic fluid, and gear lubricants provided under this contract shall be of high quality and suitable for their intended use in heavy-duty and/or commercial applications. At a minimum, all products shall meet or exceed the latest applicable standards and specifications established by the following organizations:

- American Petroleum Institute (API)
- Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE)
- ASTM International (ASTM)

Motor oils shall meet current API service classifications and SAE viscosity grades appropriate for the intended equipment. Hydraulic fluids and gear lubricants shall comply with applicable ASTM and SAE specifications and any relevant Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) requirements. All products shall be new, unused, and free from contamination. The Vendor shall, upon request, provide documentation including but not limited to product data sheets, safety data sheets (SDS) and certification of compliance with applicable standards. Failure to provide products meeting these requirements may result in the rejection of goods, termination for cause, and/or other remedies available under the contract.
