ITEMS FOR ADDENDUM #1:

Bastrop County would like to inform vendors that this contract is on an “as-needed” basis. Delivery requests and related communications will be issued by the Bastrop County Transfer Station. Please note that service demand may vary, and certain weeks may require fewer hauls.

Q: How many dumpster hauls per month does the county anticipate for the Transfer Station?

A: The Bastrop County Transfer Station averages 25-30 hauls per month.

Q: What is the average tonnage for dumpster hauls from the Transfer Station?

A: The average tonnage is 6-10

Q: Can vendors charge haul plus disposal per ton?

A: No, we need a set price per container.

Q: Is there an existing account set up for Bastrop County Transfer Station with a landfill?

A: No

Q: If no account is set up, is the vendor responsible for disposal fees?

A: Yes, the awarded vendor is responsible for disposal fees at all landfills.
